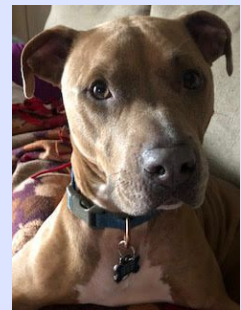
SOME FAVORITES
